Term 4 will continue to be a bucket filling term with our excursions and a visit from the planetarium. Our dedicated teachers continue to attend weekly professional learning sessions with their coach to enhance their teaching and learning programs.

A friendly reminder, that our school uniform is black shorts or tights with our school shirt and running shoes. It is expected that children wear a hat for all play times throughout the year.

 We continually update our Facebook page as the main source of information and celebration for our school community.

MAKING AN APPOINTMENT

If you would like to speak with your child's classroom teacher, supervisor or Miss Berwick regarding a concern please make an appointment at our office. Our office staff will pass on your request to the appropriate person. They will make contact with you to organise a mutually agreeable time for both of you.

INCLOSED LANDS

Schools are specifically defined as "inclosed lands". Principals can use the *Inclosed Lands Protection Act* 1901(the Act) to deal with people who enter onto or remain on departmental sites without authority. If behaviour is considered inappropriate and not in keeping with the standard of behaviour expected of people who enter onto our school site a warning may be given, leading to a directive not to enter Kingswood Park Public School site. <u>Entry onto our site is a privilege not a right</u> and the Principal has authority under the Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 to control access. This includes the capacity to impose conditions on or prohibit entry to the Kingwood Park Public School site.

MORNING ROUTINE

Our school opens at 8:25am each morning, **children should not enter the school before this time.** From 8:25am there will be a teacher on duty in Area A and Area B. Students will be able to play in these areas. This replaces morning fitness. Children will participate in fitness/physical education twice a week.

ENROLMENTS



We are now accepting 2019 Preschool and Kindergarten enrolments. We have many new families living in the Kingswood Park intake area. Please mention the great work our school provides to every student in our care to your new neighbours. If they would like more information please encourage them to come to our office for a guided tour.

LITTLE TRACKS TO BIG SCHOOL

Our transition to school program *Little Tracks to Big School* is held in our Orana room every Tuesday morning **from 9am**. We encourage any child who will be attending Preschool or Kindergarten in 2019 to attend. This program provides an opportunity for children to start making friends and learning school expectations. Parents are asked to stay with their child. At the same time we have our playgroup in action where children from any age can attend with their family. Play based activities are provided for all children.

BIKES AND SCOOTERS

Students who ride a bike or scooter to school must wear a safety helmet. Bikes and Scooters enter and exit via the front gate, and must not be ridden on school grounds. Bikes and scooters must be locked while in the rack provided. If students do not follow these school expectations parents will be notified and students will be asked **not** to ride their bike or scooter to school.

2018 INCURSION/EXCURSION FEE

Term 4 **final** payments are to be made by **Friday October 26**. Our school excursion is early term 4. Full payment must be paid to be able to attend the excursion. Please see Miss Berwick for a payment plan.

3-WAY INTERVIEWS

In 2018, we introduced 3-way interviews twice a term. Every child has a Personalised Learning Pathway which has a goal developed by child and teacher to work towards achieving each term. Families will be able to book an appointment over 2 afternoons each term so that child, teacher and parent can celebrate the achievement of the learning goal and reflect on where to next. Families of students who are identified with a learning disability, requiring an Individual Education Plan will be given a specific time to meet with their class teacher each term in conjunction with their 3-way interview. Invitations to book a time will be sent home mid-term.

HOME READERS

Kindergarten to Year 2 students received a home reading pack at the beginning of the

year. We ask that this is returned twice a week. Miss Michelle will change the books based on the reading levels provided by the classroom teacher. Students in these years will also receive sight words to learn at home to support their reading development. If you have misplaced your pack please speak with your class teacher for a new pack.



LIBRARY



Our library is open every Thursday at lunch time for borrowing and returning books with Mrs Bruce.

CANTEEN

Lisa continues to be our canteen manager on behalf of our P&C. This is the main source of fundraising for our P&C and we ask you to continue to support our canteen which provides quality and healthy lunch items for our students. We encourage ordering before the start of school.

<u>CREDIT is not available at our Canteen and there are no exceptions. Please do not ask,</u> <u>as refusal may offend.</u> Money can be paid in advance for your child to spend if you do not wish your child to carry cash.

OOSH (Out Of School Hours care)

Penrith City Council facilitates OOSH, every morning and afternoon from our Orana room to provide quality before and after school care. If every Kingswood Park family used this service at least once a week it will be a viable resource for the council to keep open. 
