MAKING AN APPOINTMENT

If you would like to speak with your child's class teacher, supervisor or Miss Berwick regarding a concern please make an appointment at our office. Our office staff will pass on your request to the appropriate person. Staff will make contact with you to organise a mutually agreeable time for all.

INCLOSED LANDS

Schools are specifically defined as "inclosed lands". Principals can use the Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 (the Act) to deal with people who enter onto or remain on departmental sites without authority. If behaviour is considered inappropriate and not in keeping with the standard of behaviour expected of people who enter onto our school site a warning may be given, leading to a directive not to enter Kingswood Park Public School site. Entry onto our site is a privilege not a right and the Principal has authority under the Inclosed Lands Protection Act 1901 to control access. This includes the capacity to impose conditions on or prohibit entry to the Kingwood Park Public School site.

We continue to welcome new enrolments for 2019. We know that there have been many houses for rent in our local area and are going to be rented in the coming weeks. MORNING ROUTINE

Our school opens at 8:25am each morning, **children should not enter the school before this time.** From 8:25am there will be a teacher on duty in Area A and Area B. Students will be able to play in these areas.


